Grossman at 10 GPM for 12 minutes with 47 ft. of drawdown (began to suck air).</p> <p>Then pumped 4½ gal./p. min. for only 2 minutes (after 5 minute interval for recovery) before running down below drop pipe again.</p> <p>Well has been pumped at 30 gal. in 20 minutes.</p>
